2. What city/town do you live in?
3. What is the name of your innovation/invention?
4. What problem/challenge does your innovation/invention try to solve?

6. Why did you take part in the Youth Innovation Showcase?
7. If you win, what will you do with the \$5,000 prize?
8. What makes you so interested in STEM?
9. What do you hope to do or be in the future?
10. Tell us about yourself - your interests and hobbies!

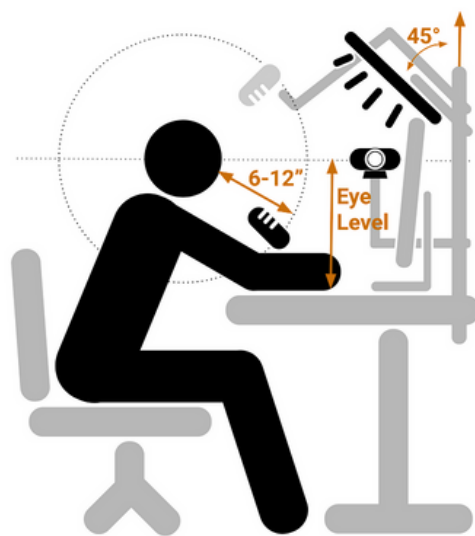


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TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

1. Record in landscape orientation
2. Be centred in the frame with equal space on either side of you
3. Once you start recording, wait for 5 seconds before you begin speaking; when you're done speaking, wait for 5 seconds before you stop recording
4. Look at the camera when speaking. If you're going to prepare a script beforehand, try not to look at your notes when recording
5. Try to be in a quiet space when recording
6. Must be 45 seconds or less of speaking time



Microphone

Position 6-12" from the speaker's mouth



Webcam

Position at the speaker's eye level



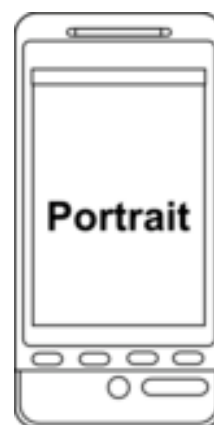
Key Light

Place in front and slightly above speaker's head at 45° angle

Record in **landscape** orientation



Make sure you are **centred** in the frame and looking **directly at the camera**



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
